'When Oliver Johnston was born on 30 July 1811 in Edinburgh Canongate, Midlothian, his father, Oliver, was 25 and his mother, Jane, was 26. He married Clementina Johnston (born Ireland) in 1845 in Edinburgh, Midlothian. They had four children in 16 years. He died on 9 August 1884 in Canonmills, Midlothian, at the age of 73, and was buried in Warriston, Midlothian.


Clementina Johnston (born Ireland)

His daughter Henrietta was born on 13 February 1847 in Edinburgh, Midlothian.





His daughter Margaret was born in 1852 in Greenside, Midlothian.




Oliver Johnston lived in Edinburgh, Midlothian, in 1870.

# Death of wife

His wife Clementina passed away on 24 July 1873 in Greenside, Midlothian, at the age of 61. They had been married 28 years.

#### Residence

Oliver Johnston lived in Canonmills, Midlothian, in 1881. Oliver's wife, Clementina, died in 1873 and he is now living at New Bakers Land, Canonmills. His daughter Henrietta (my Great-Grandmother) is married and lives there with him, her husband Johnathan A Barclay, and their children John, Clementia, Jane and Jessie. Note - I cannot find "New Baker's Land" on any map of Canonmills. There is a Baker's Place in Stockbridge part of Kerr Street.
