He then married Rebecca Boulter (Bushell) and they had eight children together. He died in 1882 in Southampton, Hampshire, having lived a long life of 81 years.

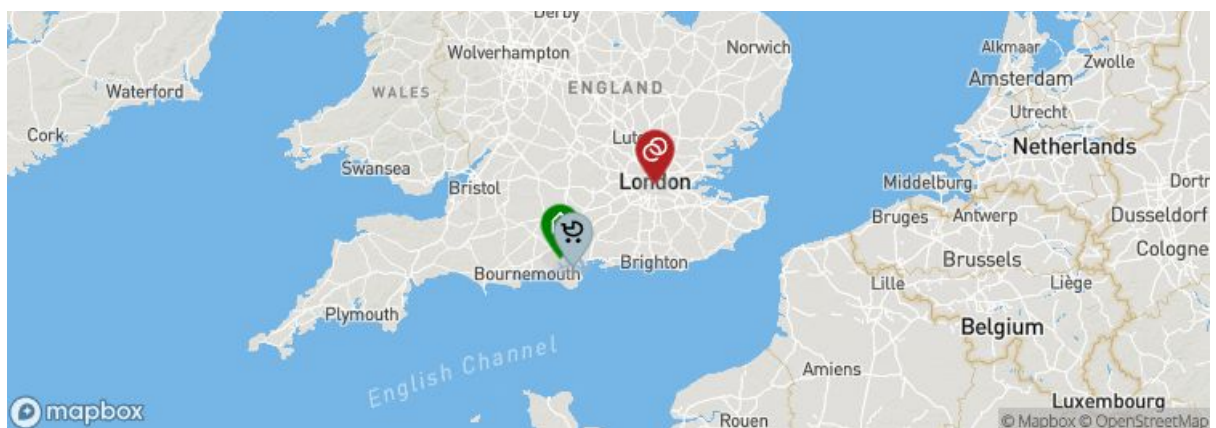
