When Mary Judana Morgan was born on 14 March 1802 in Barking, Essex, her father, Edward, was 27, and her mother, Juda, was 19. She married William J Lines on 2 June 1822 in St Stephen Coleman Street, London. They had ten children in 26 years. She died on 9 September 1858 in Ilford, Essex, at the age of 56.
